- 1. By building a municipality that helps citizens with their (application) questions;**
- 2. By building more houses in a green neighborhood, affordable for everyone;**
- 3. By respecting nature and the environment and applying the technology of the future;**
- 4. By encouraging events and activities in the neighborhood, so that you get to know each other;**
- 5. By creating safe neighborhoods to feel at home and grow up safely;**
- 6. By staying ahead of problems, so that you can offer a solution in time with regard to youth care and people who need additional support;**
- 7. By making a traffic plan to get to school or work quickly and safely;**
- 8. By supporting cultural activities for everyone and respect for municipal history;**
- 9. By creating longterm opportunities for agricultural companies for example to engage in innovative activities;**
- 10. By creating and implementing a plan to stimulate more different types of businesses in the municipality;**
- 11. By building good multi-purpose school buildings.**

OUR PROPOSALS FOR A BETTER OOSTEIND

1. **An agreement on the plan “het Dorpshart” and the village plan, so that the cultural (religious) heritage can be preserved;**
2. **Construction of houses combined with growth of nature and possibilities for recreation;**
3. **Development of Oosteind with an eye for recreation and nature conservation;**
4. **Long-term perspective for (innovative) agricultural activities.**

OUR PROPOSALS FOR A BETTER DORST

1. **A village plan (master plan) in which building towards Breda and Tilburg is prevented, with room for the elderly and young people;**
2. **Construction of homes in Dorst-south with an eye for nature;**
3. **Development of Seters as a recreational area for example by investigating the possibility of reopening of the Surae as a natural swimming pool, a vital village life and room for hospitality industry in Dorst;**
4. **A solution for the busy national road in such a way that the village center returns around the church, for example by means of an extra access road in Dorst-south;**
5. **Municipal facilities such as a new primary school building.**

OUR PROPOSALS FOR A BETTER DEN HOUT

- 1. Agreement on the village plan with regard for the preservation of cultural (religious) heritage;**
- 2. A vision for the development of the area around Houtse Meer and Markkanaal as a recreational area, taking into account existing commitments;**
- 3. Long-term perspective for (innovative) agricultural activities.**
